### **College Development Committee**

**The institution's top body, the College Council, is in charge of organizing and carrying out developmental initiatives. Since the institution is owned by the Kerala State Government, the Public Works Department of the Government is responsible for carrying out the majority of maintenance and repair work. The CDC (College Development Committee), which is chaired by the District Collector, meets on a regular basis to ensure that the budget designated for development is used appropriately. Ad hoc employees are hired to complete the smallest and most urgent repairs utilizing the PTA and CDC monies that are currently available.**

### **Constitution of Development Committee.**

**For each of these Colleges, a Development Committee shall be constituted. The constitution of the Committee shall be as follows:**

**i. District Collector Chairman.**

**ii. Principal of the College - Secretary and Treasurer.**

**iii. One teacher nominated by the College Council.**

**iv. The President of the P.T.A.**

**v. The President of the Alumni Association.**

**vi. The Chairman of the College Union.**

**vii. The Executive Engineer (Buildings)**

**viii. Four persons to be nominated by the Director of Collegiate Education. from among eminent public men and men of arts/letters (Preferably former teachers and students or parents of students of the Colleges**

**2. The Committee shall meet as frequently as may be necessary, in the absence of the chairman, a member of the Committee may be nominated to preside over any meeting.**

**3. The committee shall prepare a plan for the development of the College with a view to improving the facilities available including constitution/maintenance to be carried out during period of five years. The five year plan shall be broken up into annual plans,**

**4. The Committee shall also be responsible for the implementation of the schemes."**
