Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committee for the NSS unit's one-year preliminary activities was formed on June 10, 2021. The committee was chaired by Principal Dr. Shobha K.D., with additional members including PTA Secretary Dr. P. V. Srinivasan, former Program Officers Dr. Vinod Kumar Kattumunda and Dr. Shobha P., Palayam Ward Councillor Sri. Palayam Rajan, and College Union Chairman Adithyan A.

Activities

1. Orientation Programme for Newly Enrolled Volunteers

An orientation programme was conducted for the newly enrolled NSS volunteers at the college auditorium. The session was led by motivational speaker, Mr. Vasanthakrishnan. Students were given awareness of the objectives and activities of the NSS unit in a college.

2. Campus Cleaning and Sanitation

The NSS Unit commenced its activities on June 4, 2021, with a campus cleaning and sanitation drive, adhering to COVID-19 protocols. A total of 100 volunteers participated in this initiative.

3. World Environment Day

The NSS Unit conducted a plastic waste collection drive on campus and in surrounding areas, depositing the waste at the municipal corporation's collection centre. Bins were installed for efficient plastic waste management.

A seven-day camp was organized from February 28 to March 6, 2022, at Sanskrit College, adhering to COVID-19 protocols. A total of 100 volunteers participated. The camp was inaugurated by Honorable Cantonment Police Station Circle Inspector Mr. Shafi.
