For 35 years, the institution thrived under royal patronage, significantly supported by Rajashri and Sri Chithira Thirunal Balarama Varma, who promoted Sanskrit studies and facilitated the construction of a new facility. In 1947, the college transitioned into a First Grade Degree College, becoming the first of its kind in South India after nearly a century of excellence.
