He invited eminent Sanskrit scholars from across India to develop a new curriculum, leading to the founding of the Sanskrit College at Mitrandapuram. For 35 years, the institution thrived under royal patronage, with significant support from Rajashri and Sri Chithira Thirunal Balarama Varma, who promoted Sanskrit studies and facilitated the establishment of a new facility. In 1947, the college evolved into a First Grade Degree College, becoming the first of its kind in South India after nearly a century of excellence.
